NOTE: Against the budget provision of Rs.3286.50 crore as Loan and Rs. 403.50 crore as grant component in BE 2007-08, RE 2007-08 has been placed at Rs.5986.00 crore as loan and Rs.3204 crore as grant component towards Additional Central Assistance (ACA) to the States for execution of Externally Aided Projects. During the Financial Year 2007-08, the releases for ongoing state sector projects signed on or before March 31, 2005 are being made on ACA pattern in the loan/grant ratio of 10:90 for special category states and 70:30 for non special category states. However, the releases for new projects signed on or after April 1, 2005 in non special category states are being made on back to back basis—as per recommendations of the Twelfth Finance Commission. The Budget Provision for 2008-09 is Rs.4550 crore consisting of Loan component of Rs.3867.50 crores & grant component of Rs.682.50 crore.
