- (c) Provides for the establishment expenditure for the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister.
- 3. **New Initiative in Skill Development through PPP:** To build required skilled manpower to fulfill the needs of a growing and diversifying Indian Economy.
- 4. **Energy ( R & D):** To provide Support to R & D in the Power Sector for higher efficiency.
- 5. **UNDP Assistance:** Provides for UNDP Assistance for Preparation of State Human Development Reports.

- 6. Plan Accounting and Public Finance Management System: To put in place a suitable MIS/DSS for tracking and reporting on the expenditures along with generation of Statewise/District-wise reports on the expenditure, outputs and the unutilized amount under each Plan Scheme.
