- 3. **Chemical Promotion and Development Scheme:** Provision is for promotion of chemicals, by organizing various seminars, studies, conferences, workshops etc. and for National Awards for Technology Innovations in Petrochemical and Downstream Plastic Processing Industry.
- 4. **Promotion of Petrochemicals:** The provision is for various activities viz. for setting up of dedicated Plastic Parks in the field of petrochemicals and setting up of Centres of Excellence (CoE) in Polymer Technology.
